

- + Applicant should belong to Minority communities (Muslim, Christian, Sikh, Buddhist, Parsi, Jain)**
- + Financial assistance will be given to pursue degree and/or post graduate level technical and professional courses from a recognized institution. Maintenance allowance will be credited to the student's account. The course fee will be paid by the State Department directly to the institute concerned.**
- + Students who get admission to a college to pursue technical/professional courses, on the basis of a competitive examination will be eligible for the scholarship.**
- + Students who get admission in technical/professional courses without facing any competitive examination will also be eligible for scholarship. However, such students should have not less than 50% marks at higher secondary/graduation level. Selection of these students will be done strictly on merit basis.**
- + Continuation of the scholarship in subsequent years will depend on successful completion of the course during the preceding year.**
- + A scholarship holder under this scheme will not avail any other scholarship/stipend for pursuing the course.**
- + The annual income of the beneficiary/parent or guardian of beneficiary should not exceed Rs.2.50 lakh from all sources.**
- + The applicant should be in the age group of 16-32 years of age.**
